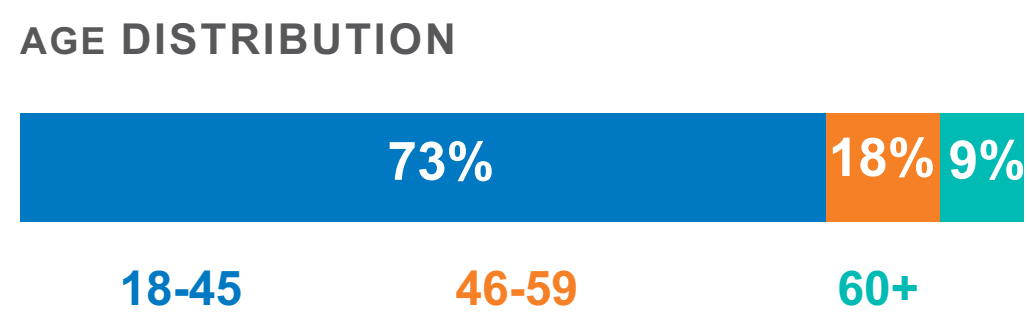

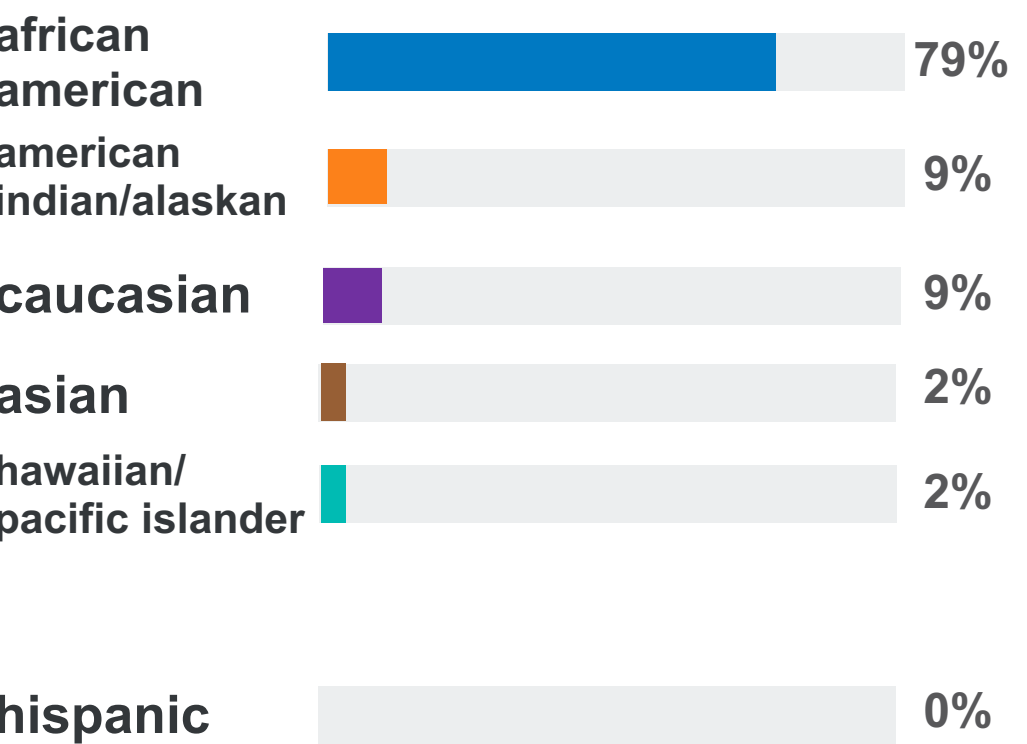

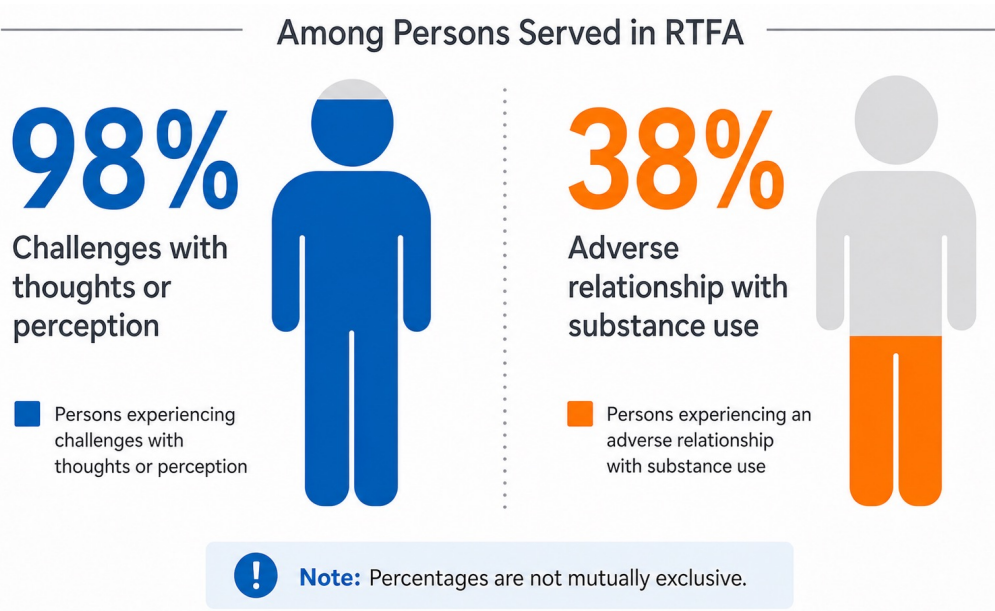
Participants take advantage of a schedule of activities designed to support their individualized emotional, behavioral, functional and community-living goals.

Of participants who discharged showed improved scores at discharge, compared to admission, on the Flourishing Scale, a measure of self-reported psychological well-being.

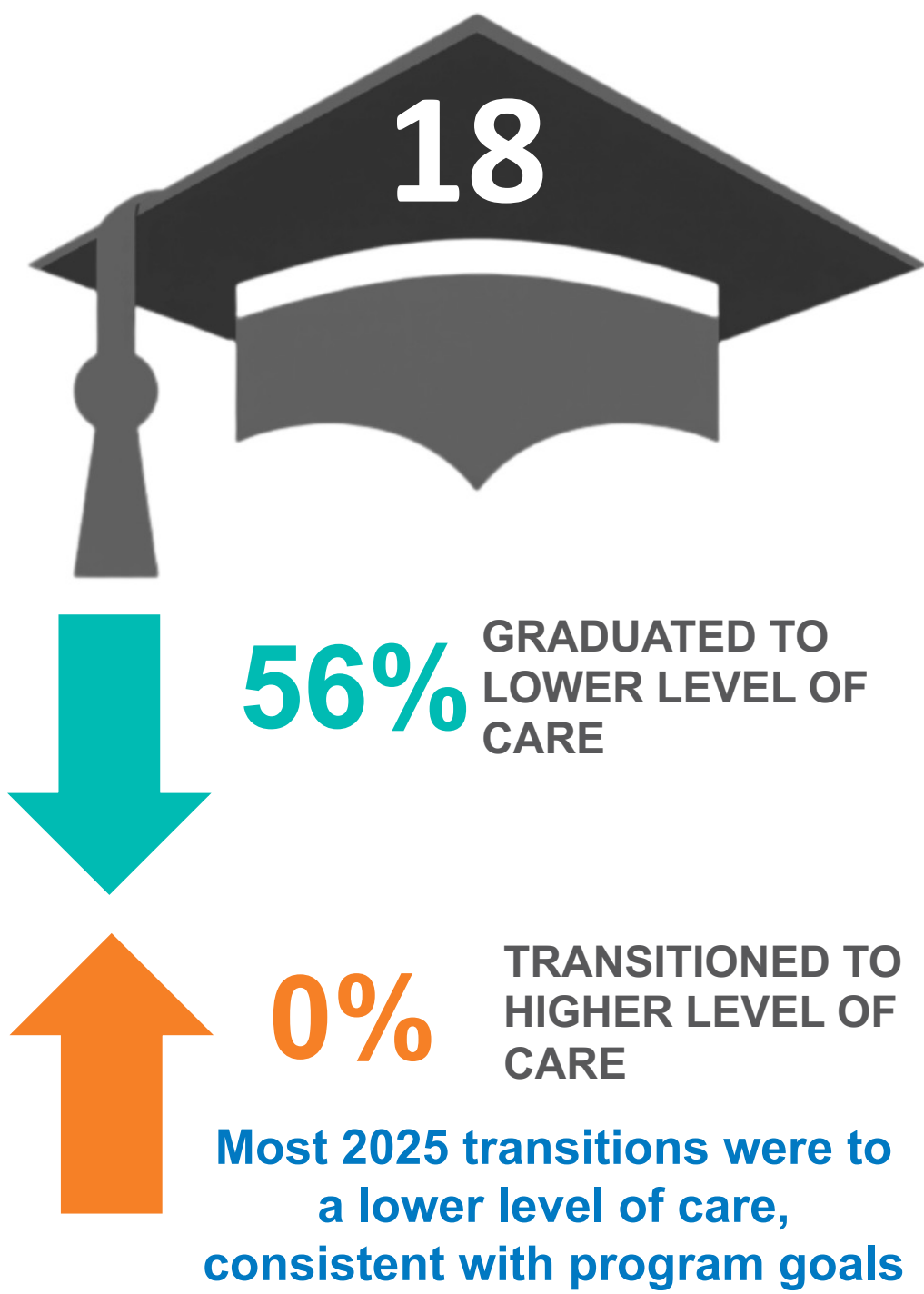
challenges we are addressing together

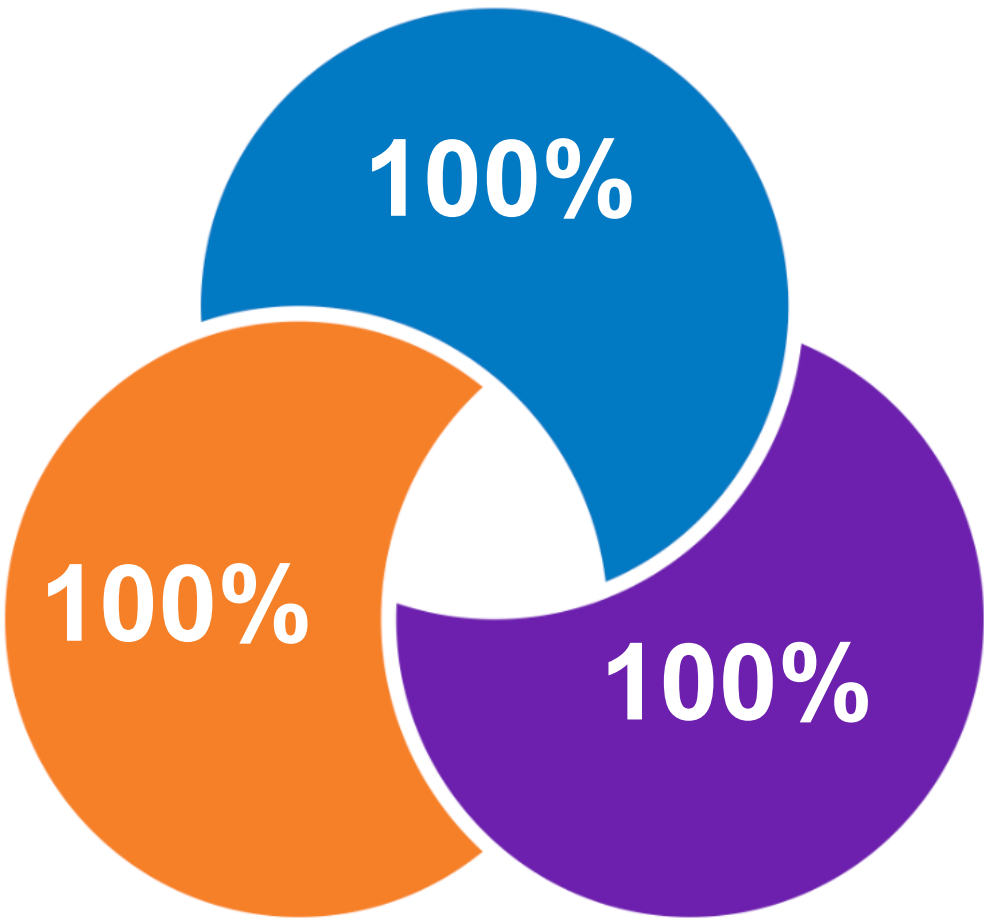

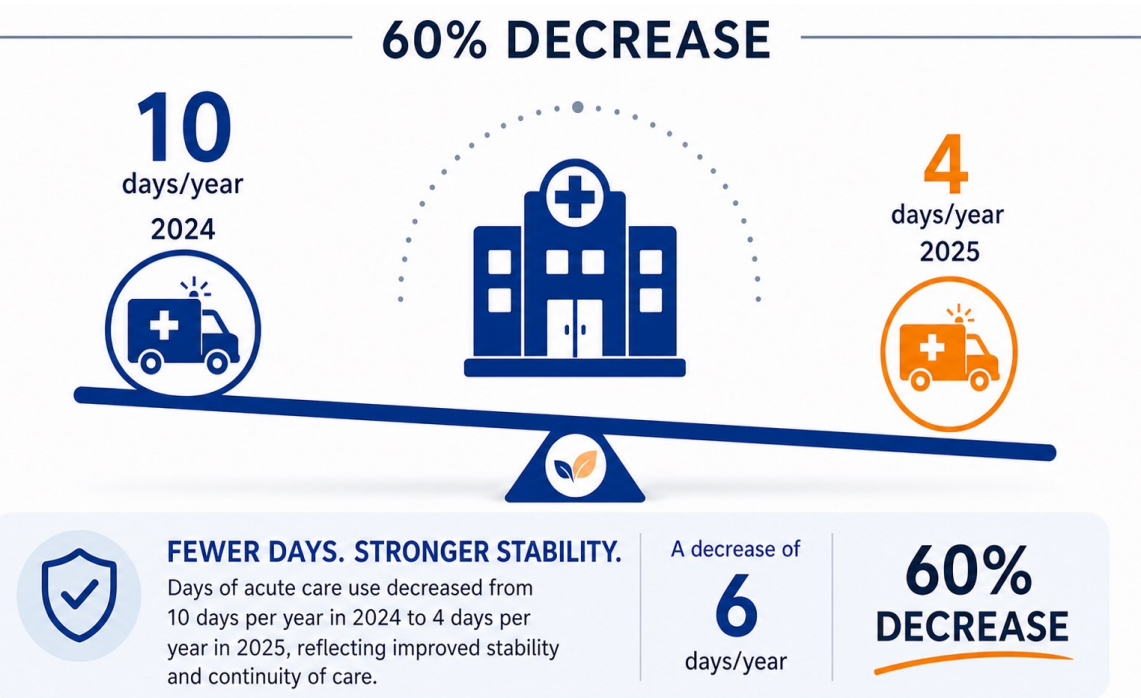
